Our reason to hope

Romans 5:1-5

We have reason to hope since rightly-placed-Hope does not disappoint!

- 1. We must place our hope in the glory of God. 5:2
 - God's glory reflects God's provision

"God's glory is seen in his provision to his people and in his concern that lies would not inform our view of his creation."

- God's glory is seen in Jesus who provides. 4:24-25
- 2. We must place our hope in God's love. 5:5
 - God's love is not earned. 5:8

"God loves. **Period**. Therefore, God sends his Son to bring about forgiveness. **Period**. God then sends those who follow his Son to share that forgiveness. **Period**. Such is the depth and genuineness of God's love."

- · God's Love is poured out for us.
- 3. Our Hope must be energized by the Spirit. 5:5
 - The spirit empowers us
 - a. In difficulty Abraham in 4:18
 - b. Through our transformation process. 5:3
 - troubles, difficulty, oppression diamonds from coal
 - perseverance, endurance, staying power
 - proven character, approved character, excellence 5:4

Faith based hope places God's revealed character at the foundation. We look forward, not to the birth of a child, but to the arrival of our Lord and our God.
